An architectural and heritage photographer widely known across UK cathedral networks.

His work – capturing ecclesiastical environments, historic spaces and cathedral choirs – has featured in promotional materials for York Minster, Ripon Cathedral and Lincoln Cathedral.

A significant portion of his signature style involves twilight and drone-assisted cityscapes, especially during major liturgical events like Advent Sunday.

He frequently photographs architectural ‘behind-the-scenes’, such as documenting specialised roof tours and high-elevation stone masonry.
